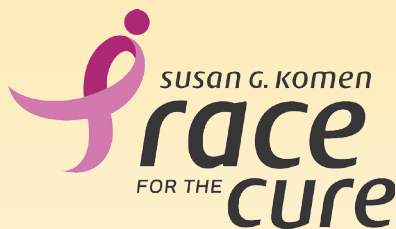

Boom Boom at *DAI*: Jen Bond's Got the Beat

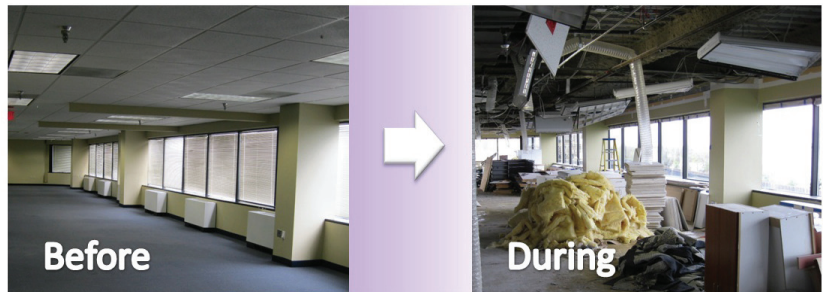
